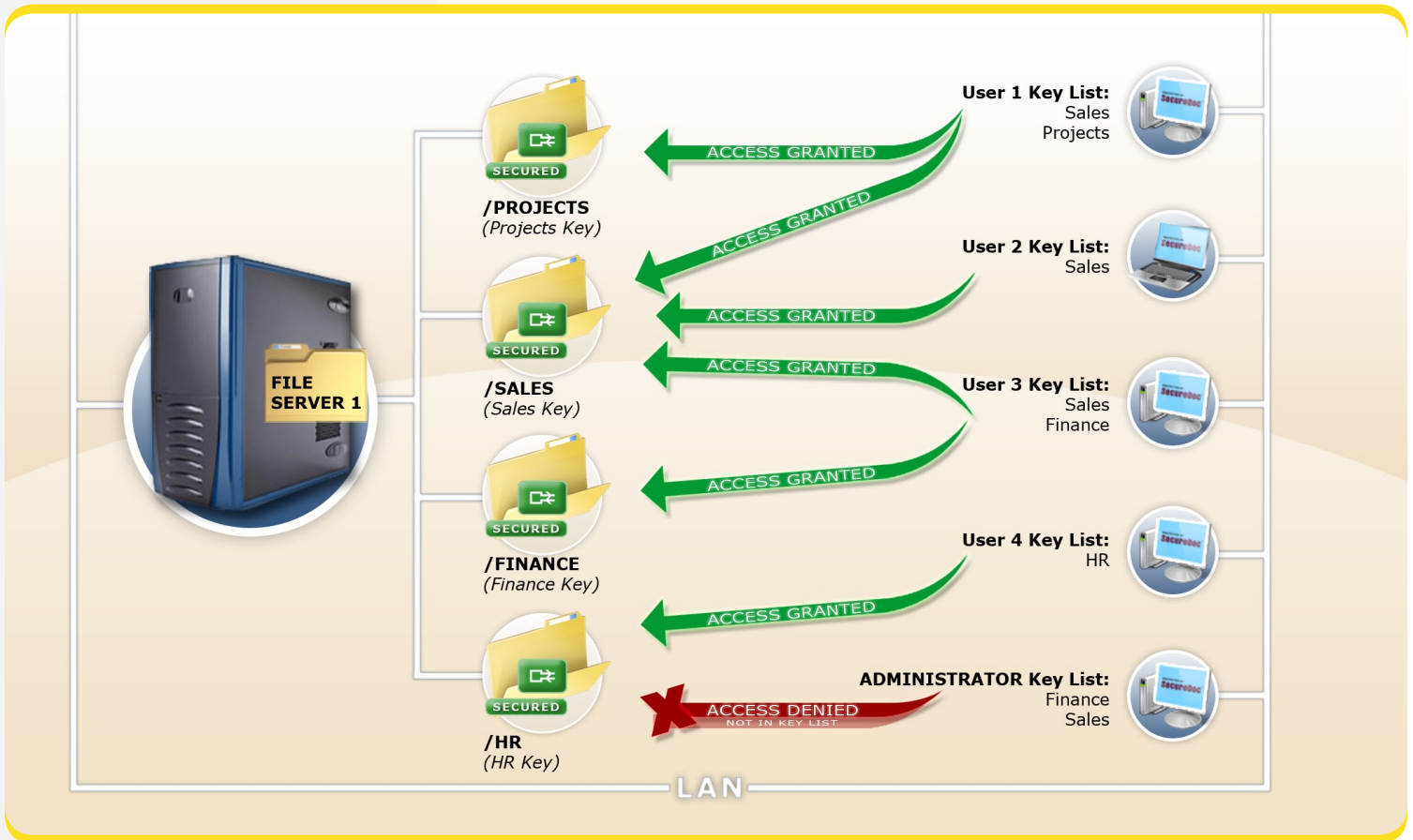

While full-disk encryption solutions encrypt the entire hard drive, file encryption is an application whereby users can manually encrypt individual files that they wish to protect. The folder encryption application allows users to move or save files in specific folders where they are automatically encrypted. File and folder encryption is transparent to applications such as MS Word, and can run seamlessly with minimal user intervention. When these applications save files to a designated directory or folder, the files are automatically encrypted. Encrypted files are decrypted when moved or copied to another location. Administrators can also centrally configure the settings of FFE applications to meet the security needs of their organization.





Advantages:

- Files moved off of encrypted drive now remain encrypted
- Protect transmission of documents by automatically encrypting them first
- Centrally manage encryption keys and provision to authorized users only
- A layered security approach to data-at-rest ensures only authorized users have access to sensitive data

The advantages of file and folder encryption are most apparent in data sharing applications, when employees and business partners might be using the same computer and hard drive. Full-disk encryption uses the same key for encrypting the entire disk and consequently affords all authorized users equal access to all encrypted data. However, FFE uses different encryption keys to encrypt and decrypt different data objects and can thereby help maintain a layered security strategy. Access to different data sets can be limited to particular users, and access to information could be enforced on a 'need to know' basis.

Benefits:

- Automatically encrypting files make IT security policies transparent to end-users and easy to use
- Minimization of internal threats and data leakage is achieved by ensuring that all data leaving an encrypted disk drive remains encrypted
- Transparency and ease of use make complex security strategies appear simple, and do not effect end-user productivity
- Security policies can easily be set and managed centrally boosting administrator productivity

FFE applications are an essential part of an integrated and comprehensive security strategy. They allow for secure information handling, and can help guard against internal threats by encrypting data and protecting data-in-transit. FFE is also useful for securing files prior to transmission over the internet. By shielding data files in transit and on shared spaces, FFE provides a strong complement to full-disk encryption, particularly when functioning under a single, integrated management scheme. With full-disk encryption and FFE support, SecureDoc is the most secure solution for protecting data-at-rest.
